Vinyl Slick Solution!

Thought you might find this interesting...I have found vinyl glue that actually holds together the Monogram wrinkled slicks. You just glue the seam on the tires with lots of the vinyl glue, let dry overnight and then sand tires with a rough emery board and the seam disappears!



You are left with smooth, real looking worn slicks with no damn seam in the middle! The tire on the left in the photo is glued and unsanded and the one on the right is sanded and finished except for the white lettering on the tires.

The vinyl glue is called Instant Vinyl, made by Advance Color Corporation, USA. The product comes carded and is in a white tube with blue lettering, and is found in the glue departments of most hardware stores.
